J. Fred Giertz is a professor and head of the Department of Economics and member of the Institute of Government and Public Affairs at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. He has been at the University of Illinois since 1980. He received his Ph. D. in economics from Northwestern University in Evanston, Illinois, in 1970.

Giertz follows general macroeconomic issues, especially as they impact Illinois. He also writes frequently on the Illinois budget and general economic issues in publications such as *State Tax Notes* and the *Central Illinois Business Magazine* and compiles the U of I Flash Index, a monthly indicator of the Illinois economy. Several recent articles have appeared in the *National Tax Journal*.

Since 2000, he has served as the Executive Director of the National Tax Association, a 1,200 member organization of tax professionals located in Washington, D. C.
