



## **John Engstrom**

John H. Engstrom, CPA, CGFM, is KPMG Professor Emeritus of Accountancy at Northern Illinois University. His teaching and research specialty is governmental and not-for-profit accounting. He was co-author of one of the leading textbooks in the field, *Essentials of Accounting and Not-for-Profit Accounting* and author of numerous articles on governmental accounting and auditing in leading journals.

During his career, Engstrom was a member of the Governmental Accounting Standards Advisory Council, the U.S. Comptroller General's Advisory Council on Government Auditing Standards, the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA) Governmental Accounting and Auditing Committee, the AICPA Not-for-Profit Organizations Committee, and related committees for the Illinois Society of CPA's.

Prior to his academic career, Engstrom was a financial manager in the University of Tennessee System administration and served as Vice Chancellor for Business and Finance at The University of Tennessee at Martin. Residing in Sycamore, Dr. Engstrom is married with five children and stepchildren, fourteen grandchildren, and one great-grandchild.
