

How to Locate the Benefit Estimator

- 1 Visit www.surs.org and click on the yellow "Member Website Login" button.
- 2 If you have an account set up, enter your "User Name" and "Password." If you are a new user, complete the registration process. There is a link on the login screen to a registration tutorial video.
- 3 After logging in, click on the "Benefit Estimator" on the left-hand side and fill in your information on the next screen.

Use of this program does not replace a SURS counseling appointment. If you are within four years of retirement, you may contact SURS for an estimate and information on filing for retirement benefits.

This program may not accurately calculate part-time service or the police/firefighter formula.
